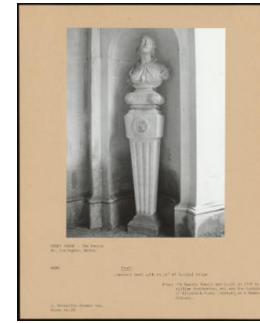

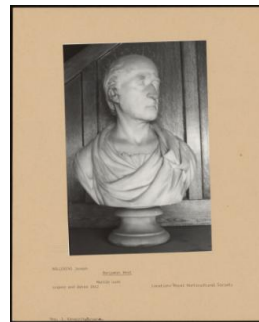

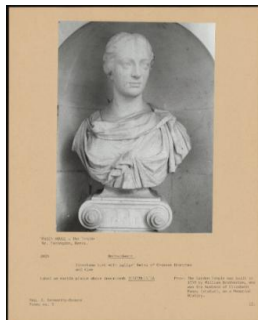

Title: detail of Relief of Crossed Branches

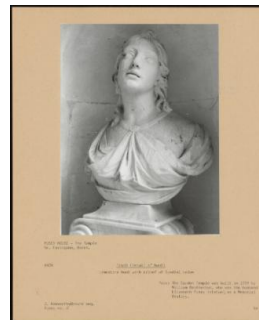
